

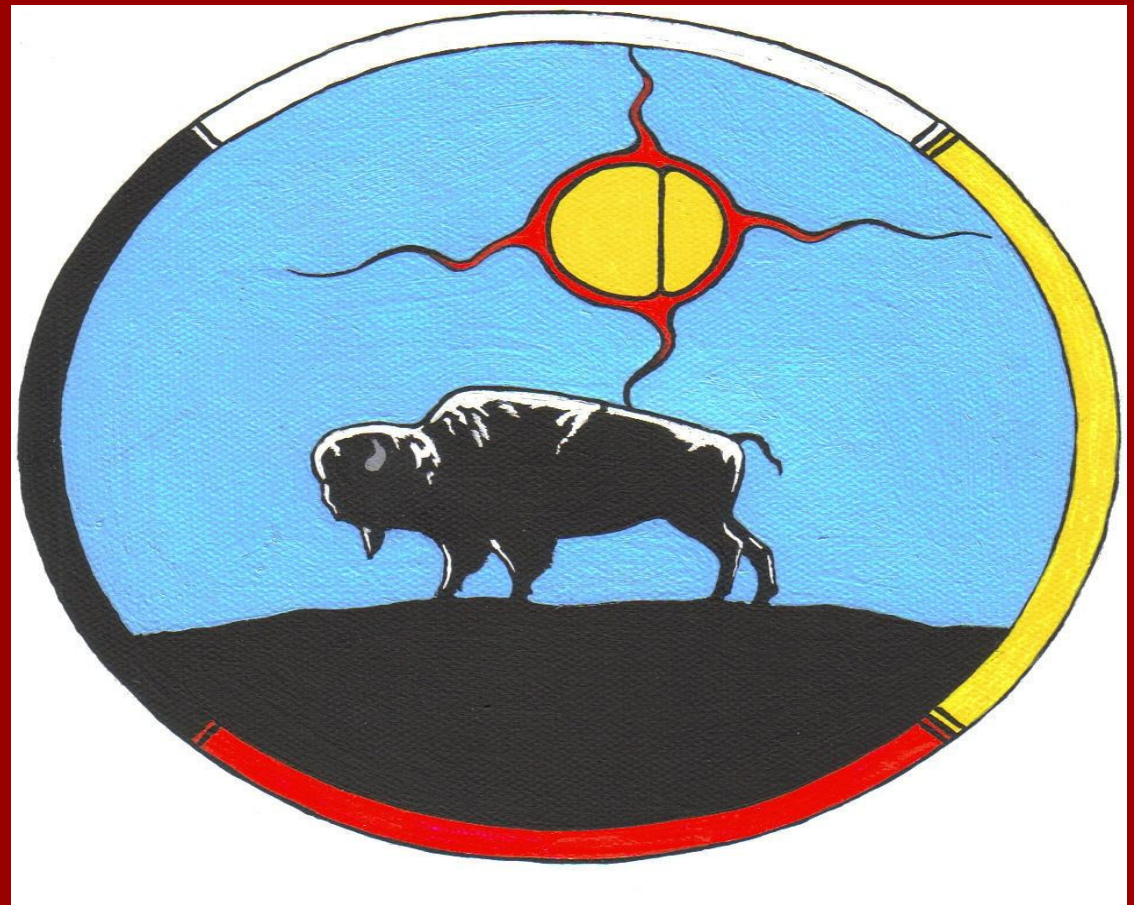
About Us
